MANDATORY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Palo Verde is a uniformed school, as adopted by the Palo Verde Middle School Site Council and consistent with Washington Elementary School District Governing Board policies and regulations. The purpose of the policy is to enhance a positive, productive and safe school environment that contributes to increased student achievement. Additionally, the uniform and dress policy standards program has been determined to be in the best interest of our students.

Description of Uniform Requirements The uniform, for all Palo Verde students, shall consist of the following:

3rd Out-of-class Isolation: Parent/Teacher Conference scheduled.
Student put on a behavior contract.

4th Out-of-class Isolation: Parent notified by teacher isolating the student out of class; after-school detention assigned by team.

5th Out-of-class Isolation: Parent notified by teacher isolating the student out of class; referral to the Office; advance One (1) Step on the Step Plan.

Any further out-of-class isolations will result in an office referral.

The number of Out-of-class Isolations reverts to zero (0) at the end of the school year.

privilege through academic achievement, positive behaviors, and daily attendance. Students must achieve a 1.0 or D average in each class to qualify for the Promotion Ceremony. If a student is suspended at the time of the Promotion Ceremony, he or she will not earn the right to participate in the ceremony. Students who have received multiple disciplinary actions for significant behavior concerns resulting in suspension(s) will be in jeopardy of not participating in the promotion activities. Parents, please note that if your son/daughter has any issues in any of the criteria areas, please schedule an appointment to meet with your child's teacher, Student Service Specialist, and/or administration.

Academics Each student must maintain a 1.0 grade point average (G.P.A.) in all academic areas. Academic assistance is being provided in regular classes and during 4th Hour Tutorial.

Behaviors Students behavior on campus is the student's responsibility. If a student's behavior results in a suspension, eligibility for these activities will be in jeopardy.

Attendance: Daily attendance is extremely important in any student's academic success. It is imperative that absenteeism is minimal and that all students are present for state testing.

After-school Activities

The Parent/Student Handbook rules and procedures apply to all after-school activities. The following guidelines outline our procedures for determining student eligibility for any extracurricular activities:

Sports Participation:

Eligibility for competition will be determined by quarter report cards and midterm reports. An academic grade of "F" or conduct grade of "U" in either report card will result in ineligibility for participation.
